

Alumnus Albert B. Travell Goes to BWI

Mr. Albert B. Travell, Membership Coordinator of the Southwest Chapter of the BWINAANA joins a team of engineers from the Power From the Son, Inc (PFS) for a trip to Liberia.

The purpose of the trip is to complete the Google earth mapping of the campus for the BWI re-electrification project. It can be recalled that a site visit was completed in July 2013 using satellite technology to locate structures. The information gathered will be used to evaluate generation opportunities and the need for a modern underground electric system.

Mr. Travell who holds a B.SC Degree in Electronic Engineering and Aeronautical Electronic graduated from the Electronic Department of BWI. He is a volunteer representative of the BWINAANA on the PFS Team to Liberia. Mr. Travell's travel and accommodation

expenses is fully paid for by the Power From the Son, Inc, Texas based corporation. Mr. Travell currently works for the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) as Air Traffic Systems Specialist (ATSS) in Dallas, Texas. The team will be in Liberia for 21 days.

Other projects being undertaken by PFS includes the installation of a modern underground system supplying electricity to 55 buildings at the war-torn Ganta Mission Station and Hospital, **which serves 24,000 patients per year**, provision of electricity for Methodist Seminary and Mission in Gbarnga, Liberia, and the electrification of the New Hope Academy on Former Vice President of Liberia and Retired Methodist Bishop Bennie D. Warner's family land in the Mambah-Kaba District.
